Following the latest announcement on Wednesday evening by the Prime Minister, NCCIL / Access Creative College is continuing to deliver all apprenticeship learning and assessments remotely.

Industry Practitioners will continue to support you virtually for the next few weeks, with travel being restricted to essential-only. Studying will continue to be set using the current mechanisms. Where End Point Assessments are booked, these will take place remotely, however, the EPAO has said should you or the EPA need to cancel due to concerns this will be re-booked at a later date.
